Answers to FAQs

Where can I find the status of my application?

If you log back into the site, you should be able to see your status.

The Foundation does not award any scholarships until after the application period is closed.

How long does it take to get a response back on my application?

All applicants will receive notification if they were awarded or not awarded a scholarship.

We are anticipating scholarships will be awarded in July

Do I need to submit a scholarship application each semester or just one for the academic year?

Application period will be open each spring (March – April) for fall awards and each fall for spring awards

I'm a new student, why can't I apply for a scholarship my first year?

You can apply for a scholarship for your first year.

If you are starting as a new student in Fall 2022 – apply to the college and then apply for a scholarship!

Do I need to submit a FAFSA application to be eligible for a HTC scholarship?

No. If you do not have a FAFSA or DACA eligibility on file, we will request information as to why it is not on file as well as your financial need.

What is considered good academic standing?

See policy 2.9: Academic Standing and Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress

The requirements for satisfactory academic standing are based on students meeting both a qualitative and a quantitative measure. Satisfactory progress will be measured after a student has attempted their first course.

Qualitative Measure All students are required to maintain a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA. (Note: A 2.0 GPA is required to graduate.)

Quantitative Measure All students are required to complete a minimum of 66.67% cumulative attempted credits.
