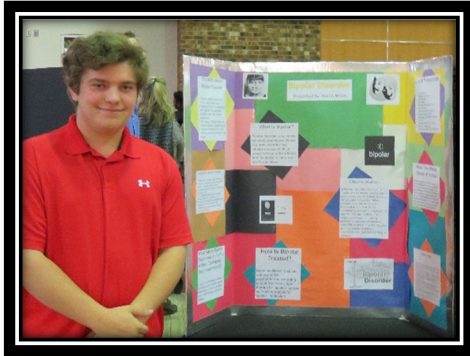

GETTING STARTED WITH ENROLLMENT

Step 1: Attend a Gateway to College Information Session

- Open to the public, during the school year, every Monday at 3:00 in the Gateway office C112
- By appointment – call 952-995-1640 to schedule

Step 2: Take The Accuplacer Test

- A college placement exam that will tell us which college courses a student qualifies for
- Tests a student's skills in reading, writing, and math
- Students should score 50 or higher on the reading section to be considered ready for Gateway to College
- Study materials are available online

Step 3: Submit Application & Essays

- Applications can be found on our website or on paper in our office
- Complete the application and write three entrance essays. The essay questions are located on the final page of the application

Step 4: Committee Review

- Once all application materials are submitted, and The Accuplacer has been taken, the program facilitator will review for acceptance
- Students should expect a phone call from Gateway to College 1-2 days after their materials are submitted
