FEATURED COURSES

Hennepin Technical College offers workplace safety and environmental compliance training to general industry, public works groups, the construction industry, educational institutions and government agencies. All of our instructors have real-world experience, as well as substantial education and professional qualifications. The following course descriptions highlight several of the many classes we offer.

Confined Space Entry

This course is designed for those who enter confined spaces to perform maintenance or other work. Topics include identification of a confined space and a permit-required confined space, rules governing operation in those areas, hazards that may be encountered in confined spaces, use of gas monitors, personal protective equipment and proper safety precautions. Basic rescue skills are covered. Technical rescue techniques are covered in the Confined Space Rescue course. Classes are available in a variety of formats from a two-hour classroom only refresher to an eight-hour initial course including four hours of practical hands-on skills using our confined space training simulator (see front page of brochure).



OSHA 10 and 30 hour classes for General Industry or Construction

These courses provide training for workers and employers on the recognition, avoidance, abatement, and prevention of safety and health hazards in workplaces. The courses also provide information regarding workers' rights, employer responsibilities, and how to file a complaint. Topics are delivered in accordance with OSHA Outreach Program Procedures by an authorized trainer. The 10-hour class is intended to provide workers with awareness of common job-related safety and health hazards, while the 30-hour class is more appropriate for supervisors or workers with some safety responsibility. (Note that this training program is voluntary and does not meet training requirements in any OSHA standard. This course description was summarized from the OSHA Outreach Training Program website.)

Emergency Responder Training

Our instructors are experienced emergency responders with expertise in a variety of response techniques. They emphasize personal safety in all areas of emergency response and effective response strategies given the resources available to the trainees. Employees will receive customized hands-on training that meets current OSHA standards for Hazardous Materials Response Teams, Confined Space and Technical Rescue Squads, and Industrial Fire Brigades. We also offer Incident Command training and American Heart Association CPR, AED, and First Aid training.

Safety Leadership Training for Supervisors and Managers

Excellent leadership skills are critical to the success of a supervisor or manager of people. Excellent safety leadership skills can help supervisors and managers become even more effective leaders of people and projects while achieving safety goals and minimizing costs associated with poor safety performance. This course provides an introduction to the concept of safety culture and tools for effective safety leadership. The overall goal is to foster leadership skills that help create and support a positive safety culture. It can be customized to your specific needs and objectives. Main topics include: i) why should we care about safety; ii) safety culture – definitions, benefits, roles and responsibilities; iii) characteristics of an effective leader; and iv) safety leadership – how to influence culture in a positive direction.

Rigging and Hoist Safety and Qualified Signal Person

This course is designed for personnel who are responsible for the operation of cranes and hoists, the rigging of suspended loads, giving signals to crane operators or the development of a written lift plan. The course includes basic rigging techniques, safe rigging practices, rigging inspection, hand and voice signals, and safe operation of overhead cranes. The course can be



customized to your specific equipment and operations. Written and practical examinations can be incorporated to document participants' competency. A typical course outline includes an OSHA Overview, Definitions, Determining Load Weight, Crane Operating Capacity, Sling Capacity, Sling Inspection, Sling Angles, Load Stability, Signal Person Requirements & Qualifications, Flying the Load, Area Clear, Taglines and Knots, Environmental Factors, Safe Rigging Practices, and Crane Assembly and Disassembly.

Hazard Communication/Employee Right to Know

Every employer in Minnesota is required to have an Employee Right-to-Know training program to make employees aware of hazards present in the workplace. Classes are customized to ensure the material is relevant to your organization and tailored to the job classifications of your employees. This course may cover the Minnesota Right to Know standard, the federal Hazard Communication standard, and federal Blood Borne Pathogens standard annual training requirements. Topics may include: GHS, Safety Data Sheets, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), Respiratory Protection, Emergency Eye Wash/Showers, Bloodborne Pathogens, Infectious Agents, Occupational Noise, Occupational Heat Exposure, and Radiation Safety.
